## 1.0 Scope

It is the policy of CLASS to provide an environment in its facility that builds independence, dignity, integration, and equality of opportunity for all our customers, students, parents/guardians, the public and our staff. Further, CLASS is committed to providing students with disabilities the same opportunity of access to our services in the same location and in a similar way as these services are available to all others we serve.

## 2.0 Level of Service

- CLASS and its member Boards are fully supportive in securing a safe environment for all students.
- CLASS shall provide integrated school transportation for all students. Where
  the provision of integrated school transportation is not possible or not the
  best option for the student with a disability due to the nature of the disability
  or safety concerns, CLASS shall provide appropriate alternative accessible
  transportation for students with disabilities.

## 3.0 Individual Student Transportation Plans

CLASS shall establish, implement, maintain, and document policies and procedures for the transportation of students with special needs. Special Education Coordinators/Consultants will consult with parents or guardians of students with disabilities that require:

- Identification of students requiring specialized transportation.
- Individual student transportation plan established for each student with a disability;
- Use of assistive devices, service animals and support persons;
- Individual boarding, securement, and deboarding plans that detail student assistance needs be established for each student with a disability; and
- Identification and communication of roles and responsibilities of the

provider, operator, parents/guardians, school staff, and students.

• Individual Student Transportation Plan will be attached to the student record within the routing software.

## 4.0 Procedures

Students with identified special needs will be transported on school buses and specialty vehicles in accordance with recommendations as provided by the Special Education Coordinators/Consultants. These transportation requirements will be outlined in each student's individual transportation plan.

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
